Enrollment is limited to 2 Instructors per year

Enrollment Requirements

Have graduated from the Pacific Coast Pilates Academy Capstone Program, or from an approved Advanced Classical Teacher Training Program, and have been teaching the Classical Pilates repertoire for a minimum of 6 years and at least 2000 hours.

Our Expectations of Mentees

Shadow both Matilda and Veronica by attending Lecture Units 1 thru 3, attending the enriched workshops, assisting on the prep and final exam days and sitting in on observed teaches so that by the following year you can teach any of them on your own.

Completion Requirements – 210 hours

Lecture Units – 36 hours

Unit 1 – Level 1 Pilates Exercises + Miscellaneous - 12 hours

Unit 2 – Level 2 Pilates Exercises + Miscellaneous - 12 hours

Unit 3 – Level 3 Pilates Exercises + Miscellaneous - 12 hours

Movement Education + Pilates Clinics (attend and assist) = 30 hours

You can attend all, but a minimum of 30 hours of attendance is required.
